



The recent camp at Valley Homestead near Myrtleford, held on 17-19th May, included 29 students plus Rotary members, and facilitators. The event featured various physical and mental activities focusing on motivation, life skills, self-image, goal-setting, teamwork, and fun in an informal and interactive setting, challenging students over the two days.
