TEC Season 4 will see the introduction of a

COMPLETLEY NEW STRUCTURE and TIME-LINE

Over the last three seasons, there has been some confusion from overlapping timelines. We were selling tickets and conducting an Early Bird draw for the upcoming season while the final draws for the previous season were still in progress, which led to some misunderstandings. As a result, once this season concludes in June, we will take a brief hiatus before launching the new 12-month format in October, when Season 4 will commence.

Here's a brief breakdown of the new format for Season 4

- Ticket sales and all draws will now take place within a single 12-month period, beginning October 2025 and finishing September 2026
- Tickets will be \$100 and available to purchase from October 2025 through to April 2026
- TWO Early Bird draws will take place before the main draws. (One pre Christmas and

one about 4-6 weeks prior to the ticket sale cut off).

- Each Early Bird draw will be for a \$2,000 major prize
- Main draws will commence monthly beginning April 2026 through to September 2026
- SEVEN prizes will be drawn each month. (2 x \$2,000 major prizes and 5 x \$100 vouchers)

The Travel Escape Club will still be the same FUN, exciting and UNIQUE progressive raffle, with many opportunities to win amazing prizes drawn over a period of months.

An overview of recent Rotary activities over the past month




